Jesus' last words are the focus of this evening as we sing and chant our way to the tomb, and then sound our way with Earth Gong and Tibetan bowls down into the underworld of the tomb. Eventually, we breathe, chant, and spiral our way back to the Divine Center, the Source of the first and the last breath of our lives, and the unexpected light in the darkness of the tomb.
